Making a star turn on the stand is none other than the Porsche 911 S 1970, which is part of the renowned Porsche collection of Peter Kitchak. The ex-racing driver and famous avid Porsche car collector owns a remarkable piece of automotive history with this 911 - one of only three prototypes built for the 1970 Monte Carlo Rally.

Though officially labelled as a 911 S, this vehicle featured the lightweight body of the racing 911ST and it marked the debut of the 915 gearbox. Equipped with a rare 2.3-litre engine, this car led much of the 1970 Monte Carlo Rally, finishing an impressive second place.

Everrati is showcasing the car at Pebble Beach to honour Porsche's 75th anniversary of the 911. This special 911 is a homage to the new Porsche 911 S/T announced by Porsche, as well as Everrati's own inspired electric Porsche ST which it recently announced will join its portfolio. Having both vehicles on the stand represents the valued relationship with its Everrati customers, with Peter Kitchak having commissioned the company to create a special upcoming project for a redefined electric Porsche.

Justin Lunny added: "Working with Peter will be a thrilling project. Peter is one of the world's most passionate Porsche collectors, his decision on an Everrati commission is a testament to the quality, care, and detail we put into every car. As with all our customers across the globe, we are witnessing a shift in how individuals want to own and invest in prized automotive assets. We're seeing a growing demand by owners of iconic vehicles to invest in sustainable luxury by transforming into zero-emission rolling pieces of art."
