The powertrain features a 300bhp cutting edge electric motor, a limited slip differential and regenerative braking allowing 'one-pedal' driving when the opportunity arises. AC and DC fast charging is also included, allowing owners to top up en-route quickly.

Each restoration will include chassis preparation, choice of paint finish and colour, a full re-chrome, fresh glass and a new hand-crafted interior. The company also offers a
